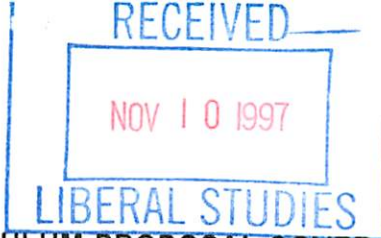

Prerequisite: EX 301
