

Part II: Course prefix change from HE to FC

The following standing course will continue to be offered under the HE prefix and will also be offered under the FC prefix:

FC 481 Special Topics

Prerequisite: As appropriate to course content

Special topics courses are offered on an experimental or temporary basis to explore topics that are not included in the established curriculum. A given topic may be offered under any special topic identity no more than three times. Special topics numbered 481 are primarily for upper-level undergraduate students.

These changes will align the course prefix, description, and title with the recent program name change. The current program title is Family and Consumer Sciences Education, formerly Home Econimics Education. Please note, these changes effect only those courses that are exclusively Family and Consumer Sciences courses.
