2. Proposed Change

IFMG 390 Database Theory and Practice

Prerequisites: IFMG210 or IFMG 230 or COSC 220

Reviews database design, data model methodologies, physical data structure, and database development and implementation. The remote data service, transaction server, and database administration are introduced. Emphasizes the practical approach in accessing the database using Internet technology.

3. Justification/Rationale

- a. For number change

This course is normally taken by most students in their junior year. The number change better reflects the level at which the course is targeted and is taken.

- b. For prerequisites change

IFMG 390 (formerly IFMG 450) teaches covers Structured Query Language (SQL) to students. SQL is a 4th generation language (4GL) which is more intuitive as supposed to 3rd generation programming languages (3GL) like JAVA. Students need to have basic introduction to programming which they can get in either IFMG 210 or IFMG 230 or COSC 220. In addition relaxing this pre-requisite gives more flexibility to the MISDS department in scheduling its courses.

- c. Course Content and Delivery:

The revision will not alter any course content, objectives, or delivery. The course will be delivered thoroughly and completely as proposed in the course syllabus of record.
