1. The following catalog description describes IM 245 Introduction to Microcomputers:

IM 245 Introduction to Microcomputers

3c-01-3sh

Demonstrates how to utilize the microcomputer in business. Topics will include hardware, operating systems, word processing, spreadsheets, data base, and BASIC. Offered for Associate Degree Program only.

Part III Rationale for Change

Because departments should regularly review their courses to see if deletions are appropriate, particularly at times of program review, the MIS Department wishes to delete IM 245 for the following reasons:

- 1. This course no longer meets the needs of students enrolled in the Computer and Office Information Systems Associate Degree program, the only remaining area where it was still an active course. IM 245 was last taught Fall, 1995.
- 2. The only program that will be affected is the "COIS" Associate Degree program. Students who are enrolled in this major are taking IM 101, Microbased Computer Literacy, in its place. Since 1995, student have been taking IM 101 instead of IM 245.
