II. Description of Curriculum Change

1. Course Description

JRNL 243 History of the American Press

3c-0l-3cr

Prerequisite: JRNL 105 or COMM101

Traces the development of the American press from its Colonial roots. Emphasizes the role of the press in political and social development.

2. Summary of Changes

Prerequisite change from JRNL120 or JRNL220 to JRNL105 or COMM101

JRNL 243 History of the American Press

3c-0l-3cr

Prerequisite: JRNL 120 or 220

Traces the development of the American press from its Colonial roots. Emphasizes the role of the press in political and social development.

3. Rationale for change

This course is a lecture course requiring some foundations in the roles of mass media in today's world. JRNL105 and COMM101, both courses that cover that material, are more appropriate prerequisites than JRNL120 or 220, which are both writing-intensive courses focusing on how to write journalistically.
