Gives practice in writing and making oral presentations based on public relations cases and problems. Familiarizes the student with problemsolving and small-group communication skills necessary for those working in the area of public affairs.

3. Rationale for Change

The level of instruction in this class is more conducive to a lower-level numbering. In addition, students may need the skills learned in this class to tackle some of the other upper-division courses.

Prerequisites were dropped since this is not a writing course and is not restricted to those considering a PR career. The JRNL220 prerequisite is a writing-intensive course, and JRNL126 is a PR course.
