New Course Description

1. HPED 175 Prevention and Care of Injuries to the Physically Active **2c-01-2cr**

Prerequisite: HPED or PESP majors

Old Course Description

Proposed Change: Add a prerequisite requiring a HPED or PESP major to take the class.

Justification for Change
