The change in undergraduate and graduate course prefixes from HPED to KHSS is proposed so that course prefixes we match the newly changed department name, Kinesiology, Health, and Sport Science (KHSS). The department name changed last year from Health and Physical Education (HPED) to KHSS. However, the course prefixes were not changed last year from HPED. The fact that the course prefixes now do not match the department name has caused confusion among constituents, and likely prospective students, as well.
