1. Catalog Description-- **MGMT 459 Seminar in International Management 3c-01-3cr**
Prerequisites: MGMT 310, senior standing

2. Proposed Change—Prerequisite change of MGMT 310 instead of MGMT 454.

Old Catalog Description-- MGMT 459 Seminar in International Management 3c-01-3cr

Prerequisites: MGMT 454, senior standing

An analysis of recent literature and developments related to global business issues such as strategic alliances, human resource management in global environments, global assignments, Japanese business system, multinational corporations in the world economy.
