Description of the Curriculum Change

1. Delete the following course:

MG 412 Small Business Management 3c-01-3sh

Prerequisite: EC122, AG201, AG202, AD235

Role of the entrepreneur and problems involved with managing a small business enterprise, especially as these differ from management situations encountered in larger firms.

2. This course has been extensively revised and is now being proposed as the new course ES 325: Small Business Management. The revision was necessary in view of the needs of the proposed Entrepreneurship and Small Business and track.
3. The new course ES 325 is a revised version of this course and bears the same name. The new suffix associates it more closely with the proposed Entrepreneurship and Small Business track. Therefore the deletion of MG 412 (old Small Business Management) will not have any effect on any other program.
