In the interest of program clarification as related to the new liberal studies program, the Department of Music hereby requests change in prefix designation of certain courses, all of which have a Music History basis, should be changed from a prefix of MU, now designated for professional courses in music, to MH, now designating Music History courses.

A similar clarification has already occurred in the Art Department by the designation of courses of AH in comparison to the courses which are designated as AR. The decision was unanimously passed at the Department of Music faculty meeting on Thursday, November 19, and has the approval of the Dean.

Please take whatever steps are necessary to effect this change so that it can be printed in the next issue of the University Catalog. Please inform us if any additional steps are necessary in bring about this change.
