ECED 250 Language Development 3c-01-3cr

Prerequisite: ECED/EDEX major. Admission to Teacher Education Step 1

I.CATALOG DESCRIPTION:

Acquaints students with the process of children's language acquisition and development through expressive skills and language comprehension. Observation, documentation, and assessment of language development across the areas of listening, speaking, writing, drawing and reading will be explored from both a theoretical and practical perspective.

ECED 250 Language Development

Prerequisite: ECED/EDEX major.

I. CATALOG DESCRIPTION:

Acquaints students with the process of children's language acquisition and development through expressive skills and language comprehension. Observation, documentation, and assessment of language development across the areas of listening, speaking, writing, drawing and reading will be explored from both a theoretical and practical perspective.

Rationale:

Based on experience from our current programs, it is anticipated that all ECSP majors will not be ready for Admission to Teacher Education Step 1 by Semester 4. To accommodate this bi-modal distribution we have developed a sequence that allows semester four (4) and semester five (5) to be interchangeable. By eliminating the prerequisite of Admission to Teacher Education Step 1 in the semester five (5) courses, students who are not ready for semester four (4) will be able to skip semester four (4) and still take the courses within the major currently sequenced as semester five (5) while preparing for Praxis I, earning the appropriate number of credits, and/or raising their GPAs. Students who skipped semester four (4) to qualify for Admission to Teacher Education Step 1 while taking semester five (5) courses may then revert back to semester four (4) and complete the skipped Professional Sequence 1 Block. The ECSP departments need the flexibility to offer the courses in this manner so students can complete the program within four years.
