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## II. Description of the Curriculum Change

1. A new syllabus of record is not required. See attached email message. The old and new catalog description is included for the purpose of comparison to the requirements. The new will be used for advertisement in the scheduling and new catalog when published.

### Old Catalog Description

SA 488 Internship 12 sh  
Prerequisite: Senior standing, all required courses in major, minimum of 2.8 overall and 3.0  
GPA in major, and consent.

### New Catalog Description

SA 488 Internship 12 sh  
Prerequisite: Senior standing, all required courses in major, minimum of 2.8 overall and 3.0

2. Summary of the proposed revisions.
  - a. In the catalog description delete the last sentence: "**Offered in summer only**". See Old Catalog description above.
  - b. The only change in the syllabus of record is deleting the words "in the summer" in the Purpose Section and changing the word "**summer**" to "**course**" in the Grade Section.
