3. Justification/rationale for the change(s).

The request for the number change is made for the following reason:

SOC 303 is not part of the SOC 301/302 (Foundations of Sociological Practice/Clinical Sociological Practice) clinical sequence; however, the number 303 and the fact that it is a required course for the human services track major is confusing to students and academic advisors. SOC 303 is a course that is important for many of our major tracks because it provides a macro perspective to social change. Thus, SOC 303 does complement the micro clinical sequence, which is why it is a required course for human services majors, but the numbering implies that it is part of the sequence and to be taken in the 301, 302, 303 order. The ONLY prerequisite for SOC 303 is SOC 151 (Principles of Sociology), thus it can be taken at any time prior to 301/302 or after or simultaneously and furthermore, it can be taken by any of our sociology track majors. There is not a logical reasoning for the 303 numbering and therefore, we request that it be changed to diminish the confusion and to attract students interested in a macro perspective about social change that are not part of the SOC 301/302 clinical courses.
