Part II. Description of Curriculum Change

1. Current Course Description and Course Number

SOC 428/528 - Child Abuse

3c-0l-3cr

Prerequisite: SOC 151

Examines the prevalence, causes, and social implications of physical, sexual, emotional, and neglect forms of child abuse in society. Child abuse will be studied from the individual, family, and societal level perspectives. Potential intervention strategies will also be considered.

2. Proposed Course Description and Number Change

SOC 328/528 - Child Abuse

3c-0l-3cr

Prerequisite: SOC 151

Examines the prevalence, causes, and social implications of physical, sexual, emotional, and neglect forms of child abuse in society. Child abuse will be studied from the individual, family, and societal level perspectives. Potential intervention strategies will also be considered.

3. Rationale: This course is a substantive sociology course that is strongly recommended to be taken for content purposes prior to the 391/392 sociological practice sequence and thus, should reflect the 300 course level and expectations of students at that level, rather than a 400 level course. It is a dual level course; however, we are simply changing the course number of the undergraduate course (428) to 328 and wish to keep it as a dual level course. Course content is not changing.
