In Nov. 2013 a comprehensive revised course proposal for WMST 200: Introduction to Women's Studies was just approved by Senate, particularly to make this course count for LS Global Citizenship Competency. This very brief proposed course revision only aims at course prefix change from "WMST" to "WGS", course title change from "Introduction to Women's Studies" to "Introduction to Women's and Gender Studies," and very minor catalogue description change to cover gender studies to make this introductory course be in full agreement with the proposed program title change from "Women's Studies Minor Program" (WS) to "Women's and Gender Studies Minor Program" (WGS). There are no other changes for this course.
