Do you want to talk to someone BUT you're not sure about reporting the incident?

You have options:

- Counseling Support Licensed counselors can assist you at the Counseling Center or can refer you to local therapists. The Haven Project or the Alice Paul House can assist you in this way as well.
- The Indiana Regional Medical Center (IRMC) can provide emergency medical care and rape kits. The IUP Health Center can provide medical attention and STD/STI/HIV testing or contraceptive counseling. Note: IRMC will give you the option to speak with the police and an advocate.

Other Resources: (The Counseling Center, Haven Project, and/or Title IX Office can assist you with these.)

- Requesting Accommodations Whether or not a person chooses to report, they can request accommodations if their safety or well-being is at risk by contacting the Title IX Coordinator or the IUP Haven Project. Examples include changing academic schedules or on-campus housing assignments, use of IUP's escort system, and adjustments to work assignments. Visit iup.edu/haven/.
