Indiana University of Pennsylvania's Masters degree program in speech-language pathology is currently under review for reaccreditation by the Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology & Speech-Language Pathology (CAA) of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) (<https://caa.asha.org/>).

During the CAA site visit, there will be a public meeting for interested stakeholders to ask questions and provide comments or concerns regarding the program's national accreditation status. We invite all interested stakeholders (e.g., alumni, students, clinical supervisors, employers, clinic patients and families, and the general public) to participate in the review process by attending the virtual meeting or by providing written comments to the CAA.
