The narrator is a college student who motivates the audience to speak up and find their own voices. Characters include a journalist, prosecutor, daytrader, politician, psychologist, and third grader. An additional character, the professor, helps the audience learn about sexual violence statistics, Title IX history, self-defense moves, and the complexity of sexual violence against women.




