## **IUP Research Institute**

The Research Institute (RI) encourages, promotes, and supports research projects across campus. The RI is a separate, private, nonprofit that works with the university to find funding for the various projects we do. The institute works with a variety of funding agencies, including:

- National Geographic
- National Science Foundation
- PA State System of Higher Education
- Department of Education

- National Institute of Health
  - US Department of Labor
    - US Forestry Service
- Department of the Interior

According to the <u>Annual Grantsmanship Report</u>, during the 2019/2020 financial year over \$8,000,000 was awarded to IUP. Federal and State funding made up 70% of awarded money. The RI has a number of resources available to help researchers pursue and manage externally-funded projects and connect with potential sponsors.

## Finding and Applying for Funding

Use the <u>Wiki</u> to search for grants and funding opportunities, submit proposals, and manage funding. Other helpful resources include: grant writing tips, managing project quality, and budget spending do's & don'ts.

The Principle Investigator (PI) is accountable for the project and compliance with applicable laws/policies. According to the <u>PI Handbook</u>, to be eligible to serve as PI one must be:

• Full-time, tenure track faculty

\*\*Temporary faculty or full and associate professors may serve with approval of Dean of SGSR and the Provost\*\*

- Doctoral students "seeking funding for fellowships, tuition, or support of research leading to the dissertation," but a full-time tenure track faculty should be named co-PI when allowed
- Others if approved by the appropriate offices and people (see handbook for details)



## Helpful People

Staff at the RI can help IUP researchers with everything from finding funding to managing those projects!

Once you receive your award, <u>Grant/Contract</u> <u>Specialists</u> help with hiring staff, graduate students, or undergraduate workers. They work to purchase supplies, modify budgets, manage sponsored compliance requirements, among many other things.
