BUILD CLASSROOM COMMUNITY

Begin with relationship-building work upfront to have meaningul classroom discussion. When contentious topics emerge in the classroom, focus on strengthening classroom community by maintaining a space of shared dialogue. Assert that everyone may be feeling a range of emotions and share a reminder about class communication guidelines.
