What Is My Role?

Ensure that your course materials (for D2L and the classroom) are accessible. This means that your images have Alternative (ALT) text, videos have closed captions, and all word and PDF files are screen-reader friendly, tagged and contain headings and styles.



Panorama (D2L)

Panorama, a tool in D2L, identifies accessibility issues. Ensure that Panorama is on your course Navbar. Panorama suggests accessibility fixes that you can apply in D2L. **Panorama does not scan video**, click this link for [Video accessibility](#) information.
