

REPORT OF THE STUDENT AFFAIRS AND ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT COMMITTEES

Thomas Segar, vice president for Student Affairs, offered opening remarks.

Dr. Segar and Paula Stossel, strategic advisor to the president for Student Success, presented information about preliminary fall 2026 enrollment trends. They reviewed unofficial enrollment data and highlighted how the university's strategic plan, presidential goals, and institutional collaboration are contributing to preliminary outcomes.

Dr. Segar presented the summer 2026 Undergraduate Admissions special group visit review, which included application, deposit, and preliminary enrollment figures. Dr. Segar ended with an update on the Promising Scholars Program, a competitive scholarship program for Pennsylvania students that blends financial support with academic and professional development, and the Crimson Scholars Circle, a specialized cohort program launched in 2021 to provide students with financial, academic, and social support.

Val Baroni, associate vice president for Student Life, provided an update on fall 2026 housing and dining, highlighting on-campus housing occupancy, meal plan participation, and enhancements to campus dining. She also highlighted the fifth year of New Student Check-In and upcoming initiatives designed to improve the student experience.

Adam Jones, dean of Students, and Donovan Daniel, director of Student Leadership, gave an update on IUP student leadership development, which continues to move forward. Rashaun Price and Liliana Myers, who went to the LeaderShape Institute over the summer, provided an update on what they learned and how they are applying it on campus. Additionally, IUP received data from participation in the Multi-Institutional Study of Leadership. The findings will inform practices in student leadership development at IUP.

An update on IUP Athletics was provided through a video presentation by Todd Garzarelli, athletics director.
